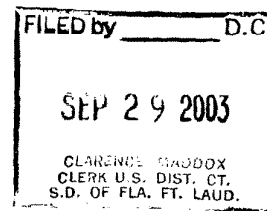


Motion (DE 34), the Receiver seeks such authorization.
